The best rosés under £25 for drinking this summer

Having sampled over 200 wines as part of [The Global Rosé Masters](#) in June this year, we can now bring you 15 top picks under £25 for drinking this summer, featuring refreshing salmon-coloured drops from Tuscany to Santorini, as well as southern France – including two celebrity-backed brands.

Maison Gutowski Grande Cuvée 2021 Côtes-de-Provence AOP

Grapes from selected parcels on the schist and clay-limestone soils of the Massif des Maures produce a delightful, almost ephemeral, wine. As is normal for Provençal rosé, the wine has a pale peach colour and crunchy red fruits with rhubarb crumble and rose petal accents. Medium-bodied, the wine has superb concentration, lovely definition and brisk acidity with apricot and lemon-lime citrus nuances coming through on the palate. This is a serious wine destined for fine dining; lobster Newburg or salmon soufflé are dishes of choice. (Patricia Stefanowicz MW)
